*You are going to have a conversation with a partner using some of the topics from units 1, 2, 3 and 4 in your book.

*You should be prepared to ask your partner 8 questions, and be ready to answer your partner's questions.

*Who is your partner? What questions will he or she ask? That is a mystery, but don't worry. The questions will be from your textbook, so you can prepare for any questions you may be asked.

Some example questions could be...

- What's your hometown? How do you spell it?
- How many brothers or sisters do you have?
- Can you describe someone you know well?
- What kind of person are you?
- What does your family like to do?
- What do you like to do?
- Do you like sports?
- What do you like to do on rainy days?

*When you have your conversation, it is very important to speak naturally.

1. Starting a conversation.
2. Ways to continue a conversation, asking and answering questions. (Extra information, follow up questions).
3. Showing interest and reacting to what your partner says.
4. Finishing the conversation.
