



Card game *Play this game in groups of 3 or 4*

- * Cut out the cards & put them face **up** on the table.
- * Your teacher will say one of the words on the cards. >> Any player should quickly snatch the card, and **immediately** make a sentence including the word and one of the expressions in the box above.
- * Other people in the group decide if it is a good sentence. If it is, you score a point. If it is not, you get a **minus** point, & another person in the group can try.
- * You score a **bonus point** if you make a long sentence (“....., because”).
- * Put the card **back** on the table, face up.
